### Message from the Deputy Head of Primary Department

### Dear Parents,

Happy World Maths Day! This week, GEMS WSR has celebrated World Maths Day with a whole week of activities happening across the school, KG1 - Grade 12.

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Mathematics is a popular subject across WSR; be it in KG1, Primary or Secondary, children love to be engaging with mathematical learning and enquiry. There are many reasons why Maths is such a popular subject in schools across the world, particularly within our WSR community; I think the biggest factor is that it is the same in every language. It is a universal and global constant. GEMS WSR is proud to represent 65 different nationalities between our more than 3000 students. For many of these students, English is not their first language and therefore they can sometimes struggle to access certain curriculum areas. Though we may come from different places and speak in different tongues, 1 is always 1 and 2 is always 2.

One thing that does change however is how children are taught Maths. How Mr. Martin was taught maths is different to how I was taught maths, which in turn will be different from how many of you as parents were taught maths. As a direct result of this, I would like to introduce you to our WSR Calculation Policy for Primary. This policy explains in detail the different stages children have to go through over their time to develop a secure conceptual derstanding of the written method for each of the four main operations. This policy can be used to support you in better understanding how your children are being taught in the classroom and allow you to continue this when you follow up learning at home.

Ms. Asa (Deputy Head of KG1), Ms. Swati (Leader of Learning for Mathematics in KS2), Ms. Andrea (Leader of Learning for Mathematics in KS1) and I introduced this policy in Tuesday's Primary Parent Workshop. During this session, I explained and modelled the process of using concrete resources, pictorial representations and written methods to solve calculations in each of the four operations. For those of you who could not attend, I have included direct links to the video demonstrations shared during the session that are now available on our YouTube channel. I have also included a picture of the completed board used to further model how the concrete exploration progresses to pictorial representation and written method.

When we use the words concrete, pictorial and abstract – words that you will find frequently used throughout our Calculation Policy and within the classrooms, we are referring to the various stages of representation and exploration to develop the conceptual understanding necessary to solve calculations with a fluent ease. Concrete resources are used in the initial instance to allow the children to practically complete the calculation. The use of resources not only means the children are able to physically move the numbers and digits but it also reinforces their understanding of the value of each digit within a calculation. The pictorial representation stage allows the children to draw out and represent the process they have followed with the resources, as they begin to put the method to paper. The children will quickly see the link between the concrete resources to the value they are assigning them and how the written method will be arranged. The final stage is the abstract stage, the numeric written method that children need to use. This means the children have demonstrated their conceptual understanding of the process by successfully being able to solve calculations with both concrete resources and pictorial representations. This learning can then be applied by using numbers and digits to complete the calculation formally.

During our assessments, whilst children will not have access to the resources we use in class, children will still be free to solve the calculations in a method they feel most comfortable with – be it pictorial or written/abstract. Children learn at their own pace, this means that if your child is comfortably exploring a calculation in a pictorial from but still struggling to make that step into the written method, do not worry.

Whilst this WSR Calculation Policy is primarily aimed at Primary, the concepts that are woven throughout it can apply to children in EYFS and Secondary too. Just as how the learning of each operation begins with exploration through concrete resources, as does the mathematical learning journey in KG1. Children will begin to explore number, shape and measure through their regular maths lessons. In this time, children will be exposed to a range of resources that allow them to apply their taught knowledge in their independent play (for example, before they are expected to write 6, they need to know what 6 is and be able to represent this in a range of different ways).

The learning is also then stretched up into secondary when their algebraic understanding will also be stretched; to solve this range of increasingly complex and extended calculations, the children will need a deep and secure fundamental conceptual understanding of all the operations and be able understand the formulas and complex equations they have to solve. Alongside this will be the necessity to use the correct vocabulary at all times to explain mathematical reasoning and understand abstract questioning.


