Please note that RLP is On Line Learning Only

Please note that we are unable to offer face to face learning for children other than on the dates specified above. From 4th October 2020 you can send your child to school for blended learning regardless of their Grade. All Grades will be able to be in school for Blended Learning from 4th October 2020.

Which group will my child be in?

Class teachers will begin to allocate and notify you of your child's group. Please note that all siblings will be allocated to group A. This will happen across the whole school (Primary and Secondary) to ensure that siblings are able to travel to school together on the same days.

What will the school timings be?

School timings for Grades 1 to 5 will be 7:45 to 1:45pm. The day will have 6 lesson periods. Each lesson will have a 15 minute break in between to allow your child to take water, eat a snack, wash/sanitize their hands and use the bathrooms.

Will my child need to wear a face mask?

If your child is 6 years old or above, please ensure that you send them to school with two face masks. They must also be marked with your child's name. Please note that for children aged 5 years and below it is not mandatory for them to wear a mask in school.

What does my child need to bring to school with them?

- Your child must bring their own stationery to school,
- Healthy snacks/packed lunch,
- Bottled water,
- A charged device with WIFI connection capability. Your child will not be using this device all day, but as we are unable to share any paper in school, the teacher will be able to share texts that they will need to access the learning. They will also be able to join in with Kahoot and MS teams quizzes that the teacher will set.

Please note, children will not be able to share anything they bring in – all children will need their own individual things.

Where will I drop my child in the morning?

If your child is in KG1 or KG2 you are permitted to go to their classroom and stay in the building for a maximum of 10 minutes.

If your child is in Grades 1 to 5, you will need to drop them at the front of the school, parents are not permitted to enter the school building with their children from these Grades.

Where can I collect my child at the end of the day?

KG1 & KG2 – you can collect your child directly from the classroom.

Grades 1, 2, 3 – you can collect your child from the upper and lower shaded areas at the far right of our school building. Please ensure that you enter via Gate 2, collect your child from the shaded area and continue to walk through to Gate 4 where you can leave the school campus. Please adhere to the one way that we have been instructed to implement for the safety of the children, families and staff at WSR.

Grades 4 & 5 – these children will be dismissed from their classroom and will be able to either go to the upper and lower shaded areas to meet their siblings and wait to be collected or they can meet their parent at the gate and leave the campus with them.

Where will I go if I collect my child late?

If you collect your child late you will need to go directly to Gate 5 and walk through the bus area to the schools MPH (Multi-Purpose Hall). Late children will be held here.

Finally, please do not send your child to school if...

- They are not feeling well and are suffering from fever, runny nose, diarrhea, sore throat or muscle pain
- If any of your child's siblings are suffering from any of the above
- If any family member has arrived from another country and is under self-quarantine
- If any member of the family is detected COVID-19 positive and is in isolation or on medication
- If any member of the family has been advised to take a COVID-19 test and you are still awaiting the results

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Please be assured that these timings have been put into place to ensure the safety of your children. Do adhere to these dates. If your child comes to school in the wrong week, we will be calling you to come and collect them. We have been given strict guidelines by the MOE as to how many children we are allowed on our campus each week.

If you need further clarification please speak to your child's Class Teacher, Grade Leader or a member of my SLT who will be more than happy to help you.

Thank you for your continue support to help us ensure that our children, families and staff remain safe during this pandemic.

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RE: Returning to school - important notices for grade 10-12 students

We are really excited about welcoming your child back to school (or online) on Sunday 6th September at 7.45am. If you have chosen the Remote Learning option for your child, then please ensure they log-on from 7.45am onto their Google Classroom each morning. If your child does not have their tutor's Google Classroom Tutor Group code, please email the school's IT support team - studentithelpdesk_wsr@gemsedu.com

Please read the important notices below with your child in preparation for their return to school on Sunday:

- Students will have an extended tutor period on Sunday morning to support their transition back to school. Important information for the rest of the week will be shared by tutors.
- Students will only be allowed on the school premises if they have a negative COVID19 certificate. This should have been emailed to your child's form tutor by Friday 4th September.
- Teachers are aware that not all students will have purchased subject textbooks, and lessons will be planned accordingly. Students will be given additional time to do so.
- Ensure you do not send your child to school if they are displaying any symptoms of illness (i.e. runny nose, dry cough, high temperature, etc.)
- Ensure you send your child to school daily with 2 disposable masks, a packed lunch (or ensure there are adequate funds on your child's lunch card to purchase food) and water bottles.
- Students must maintain effective social distancing as per instructions inside the building.
- Ensure that your child attends school every day (either physically coming to school or online).
- Secondary school students with their own transport facility will use Gate no 2 & 3 to enter the school campus. These gates will be open from 7:15am each morning. (Please see figure 1 below for further guidance on entry points and gate numbers.)
- Students will have to pass through thermal scanning at the school entrances
- Students arriving to school by bus transport will have to pass through thermal scanning via the Multi-Purpose Hall.
- Kindly follow the school traffic plan and enter and leave the school premises by the designated gate.
